NEW WEBSITE LAUNCHING FEBRUARY 2020!

Registrations may be processed online or in person. We accept Cash, Credit (Visa, MC, Discover), and checks (made out to Southborough Recreation). Registrations will not be taken after the posted deadline dates. Registrations that require additional paperwork (i.e. medical forms) will not be considered complete until all paperwork is received. THERE ARE NO REFUNDS unless for class cancellation or a medical condition in which the Recreation Department will require a doctor's note. Programs will not be prorated for any classes missed.

CANCELLATIONS

Cancellations for Recreation Department sponsored programming will be announced by the Recreation Department. Email will be utilized for all participants registered into a program. The Recreation Department reserves the right to cancel programs for any reason they deem necessary (weather, enrollment numbers, safety, etc.).
