Southborough Recreation Close-Contact Policy Recreation After School Programs

Updated 11.01.21

Per the guidelines set by the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE) and the Department of Public Health

If your student is identified as a close contact of a COVID-19 positive case during school:

1. You have the option to participate in the “test and stay” program OR do a strict quarantine at home
2. If you choose to participate in “test and stay” the Recreation Department is recommending following the DESE/DPH guideline that says any time your student is not in school; they will need to follow a strict quarantine
3. **Even if your student’s test is negative, they will not be permitted to participate in non-school sponsored events until AFTER the end of the 7th quarantine day. Your child will be permitted on the 8th day.**

If your child is exposed to a positive COVID-19 case during a NON-SCHOOL sponsored extracurricular activity (scout meeting, youth sport program, etc); your student CANNOT participate in the school test and stay option and need quarantine at home.

The Southborough Recreation Department and its Recreation After School Programs (RAP) are non-school programs. Therefore, the policy above relates to all Recreation sponsored programs.

If you are affected by this, and unable to attend a class, the Southborough Recreation Department will apply a credit to your household for any missed class if requested.
